


Logging in as a Manager or Coach


Step 1 – Logging in

When added to the system, managers/coaches/administrators receive passwords either to their mobile, email or both which they use to log in (by clicking on the Club/Coach Sign in). What they get access to once logged in, depends on the level to which they have been added. For example, coaches added to teams will only see that team listed when they log in, but club/school administrators will see the whole club/school structure and have the ability to send messages to everyone registered within the club/school and make changes.
